REPORTS

Police Report – Chief Dood reported for the Police Department and noted the DOJ awarded the Village Police a grant for ballistic vests. He also presented the Village Manager’s report. He shared an update on the DEQ bids and noted Officer Campbell resigned to take a full-time position. The School Resource Officer position has been filled by Officer Brandon Allen. Chief Dood talked about the blight issue and enforcements that are currently taking place.

DPW – Mike Vellanti, DPW Supervisor, added to his written report and noted the downtown lights have been completely rewired.

Airport – Clark Newell, Airport Manager, reported on items that have been taking place at the airport. He will be presenting information and a proposal on an airport courtesy car.

Case moved and Lobert seconded to add Darin Dood to the Chemical Bank signature card and authorize him for banking transactions. Motion carried.

Information and Comments: Huttinga asked about process to hire a new Village Manager.

Clark Newell, Airport Manager, noted the above-ground gas tank needs attention. He will look into it further and report back to the Council.
