REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
June 12, 2017

Pledge of Allegiance

AGENDA APPROVAL – Lobert moved and Lund seconded to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – Jim Wood, 420 Sherman Street, addressed the Council regarding storefront names. He encouraged the Council to enhance the historical names on the buildings in the downtown area. This item will be referred to the DDA.

STANDING ITEMS

Lobert moved and Fryover seconded to approve the regular meeting minutes of May 8, 2017, as presented. Motion carried.

Lobert moved and Lund seconded to approve the bills in the amount of \$54,378.69, as presented. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Police Report – Chief Dood did not have any additional information to add to his written report.

DPW – Brian Bucholtz did not have any additional information to add to the DPW written report.

Airport – No report

Village Manager – Shay Gallagher, Village Manager, added to his written report and shared he had attended the Michigan Rural Water Program seminar. The Village will review water and sewer rates. An inspection of the water tower has been completed. A “Lake Clean-up Day” was recently held. Village Manager Gallagher thanked those who gave of their time to make this day a success. Updates were also given regarding OSHA requirements and a DPW safety manual, as well as the status of the

airport trees. He also reported on the 10th Street project, Act 51 new compliances, and the Parker Hannifin situation.

Kathy Barnes, Blue Start Mothers, addressed the Council and asked for permission to host the Third Annual Parade in honor of 911 Patriots Day.

Lund moved and Lobert seconded to approve the 911 Parade and commemorate Patriot's Day. Motion carried.

Village Manager Gallagher presented budget amendments. Lobert moved and Case seconded to approve the budget amendments as presented. Motion carried.

Manager Gallagher reported on the new DPW building location at North Street. Case moved and Lobert seconded to approve a well for the DPW building not-to-exceed \$7,000. Motion carried.

More information will be provided to the Council at the July meeting regarding options for the DPW Building.

Cross Connection requirements and ordinances that need to be updated were discussion. Lobert moved and Fryover seconded to approve the Cross Connection Ordinance as presented. Motion carried.

Chief Dood and Manager Gallagher presented information on the COPS Grant. Case moved and Lund seconded to approve the COPS Grant and support Chief Dood in the process. Motion carried. Lund asked for projected numbers on how this is benefiting the Village of Lakeview.

The Planning Commission has a vacancy to be filled. Lund moved and Lobert seconded to appoint Lynn Saxton to the Planning Commission. Motion carried.

A ZBA vacancy needs to be filled. Lobert moved and Lund seconded to appoint Chris Fryover to the ZBA Committee.

Lobert moved and Lund seconded to adjourn at 8:25 a.m. Motion carried.
