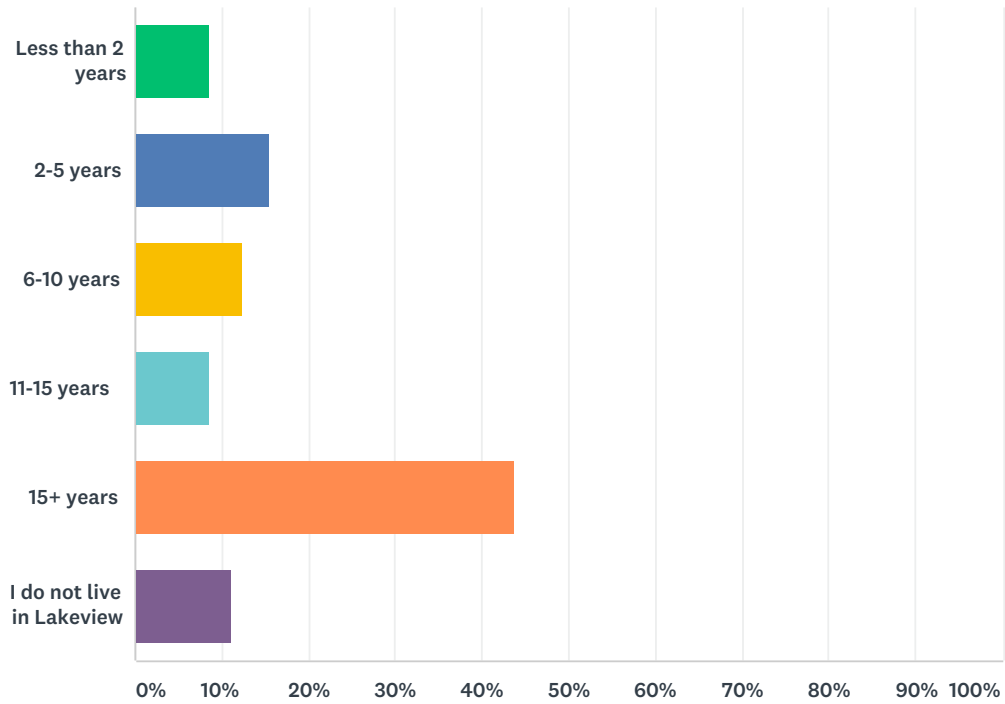

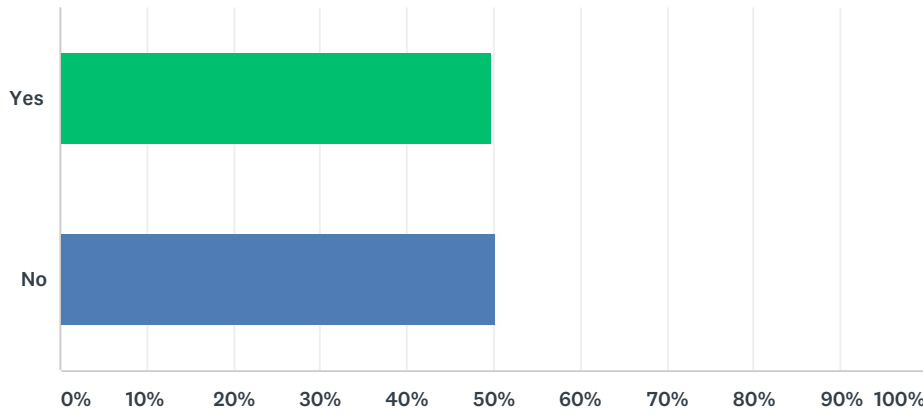

Q2 Do you have any children under the age of 18 living in your home?

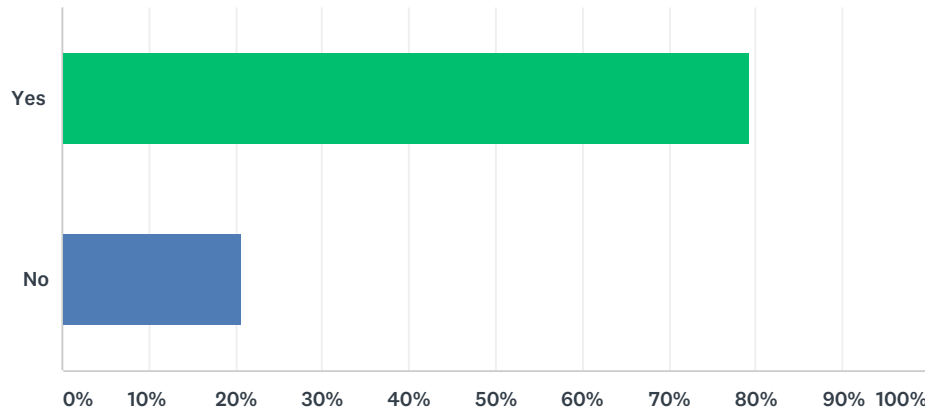

Q3 Are you a registered voter in the Village of Lakeview

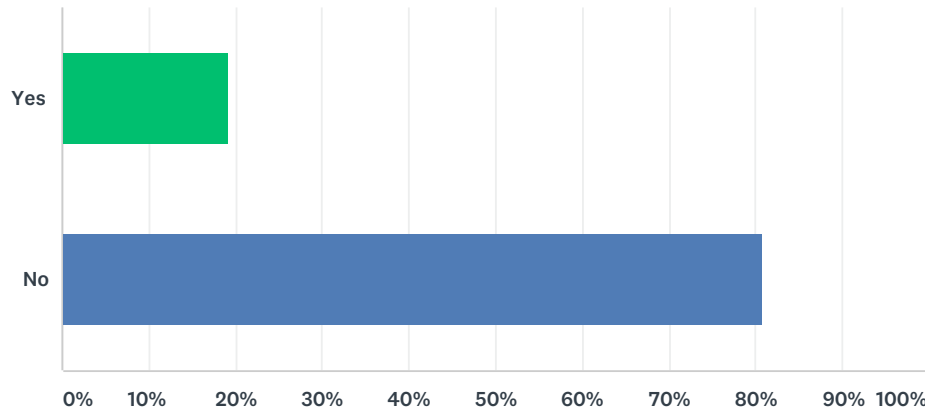

Q4 Are any members of your household age 65 or older?

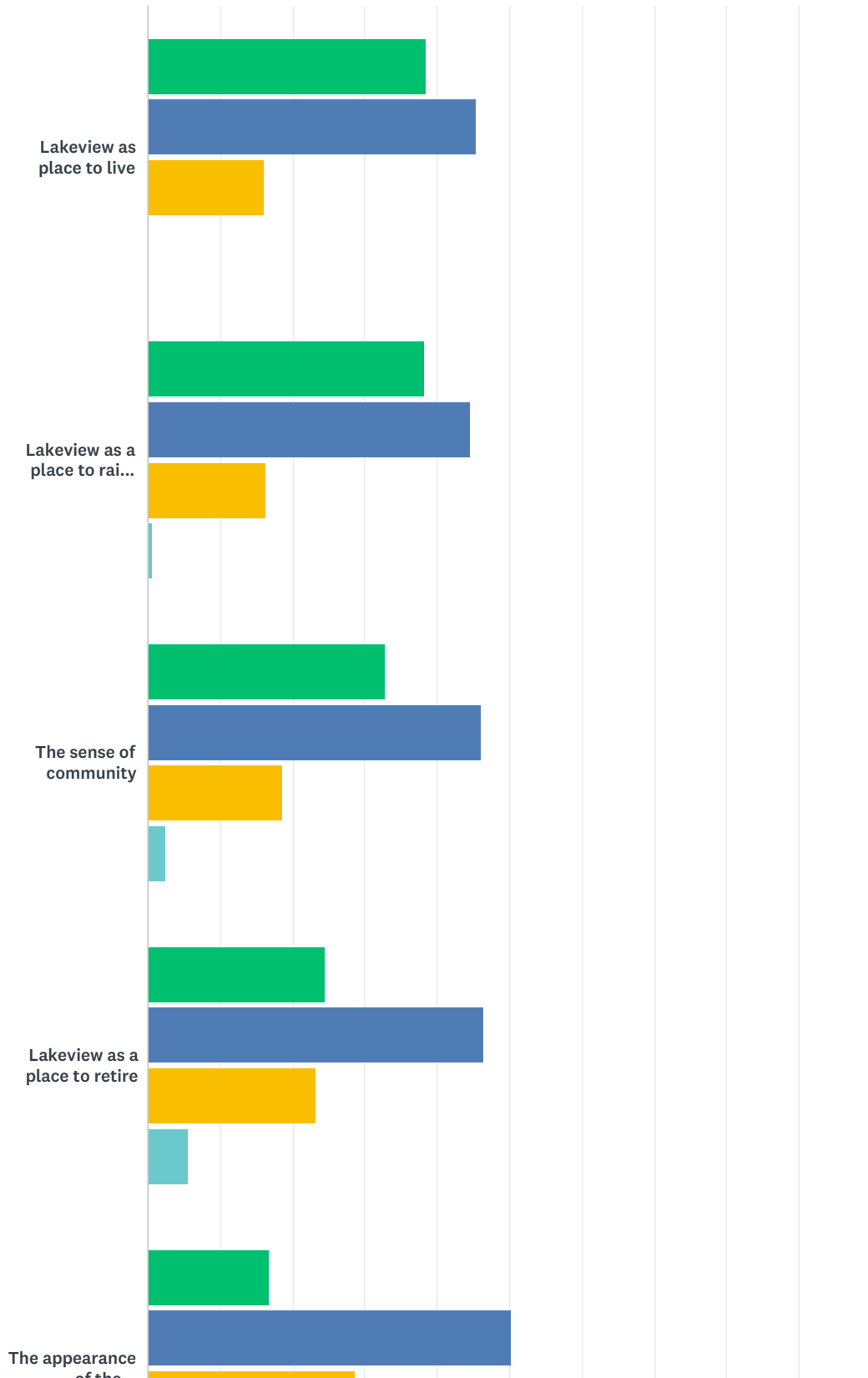

Q8 Which single characteristic is your main reason to continue living in Lakeview?

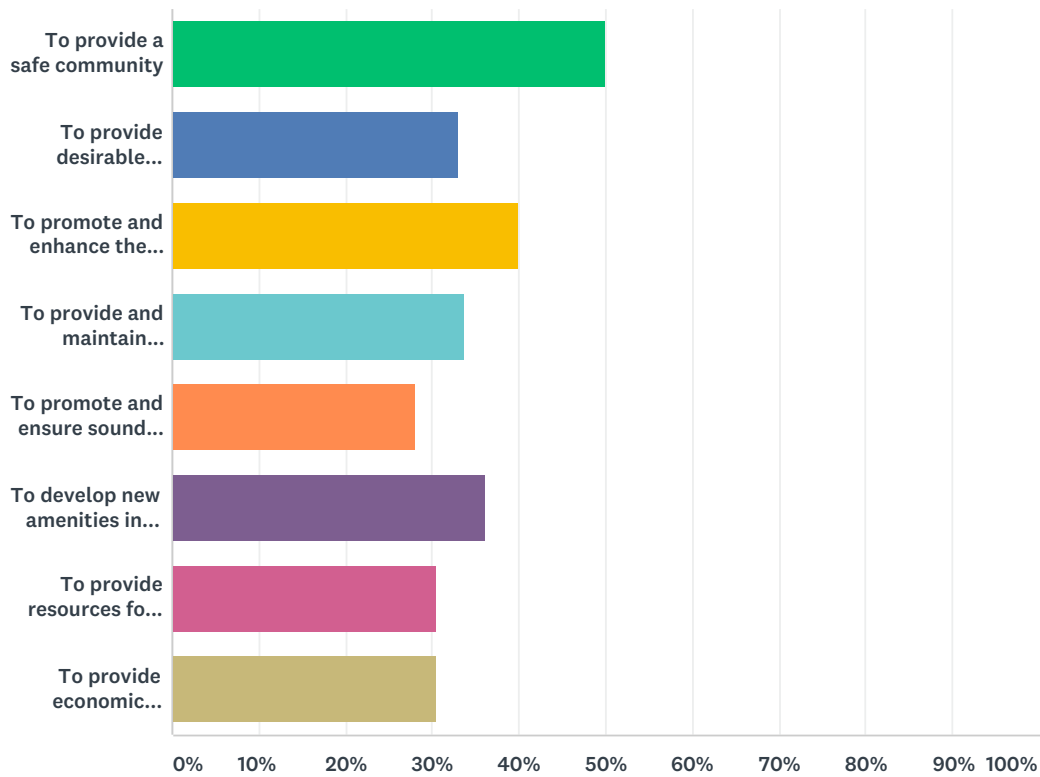

Q16 On average, how frequently do you use the lake during:

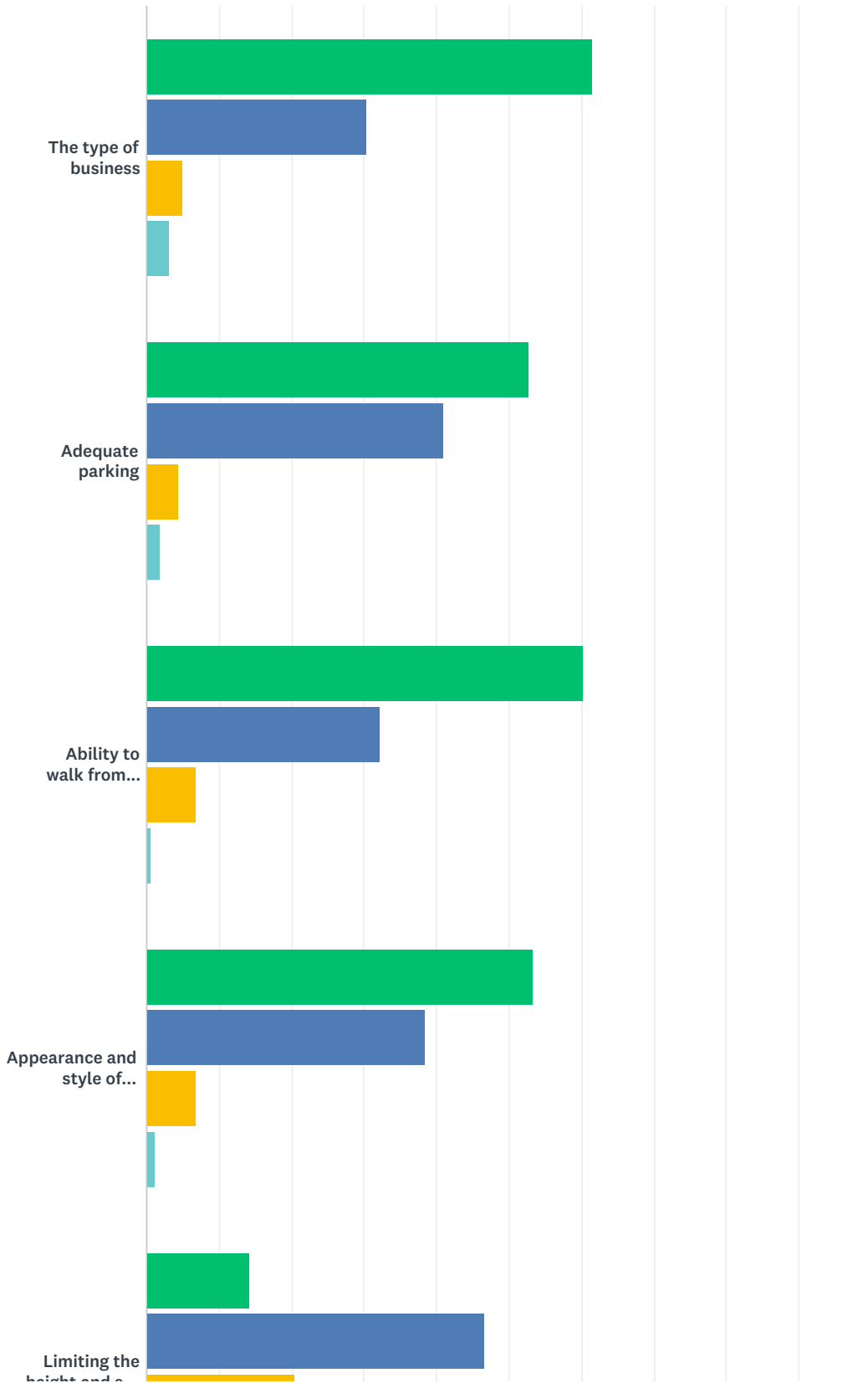

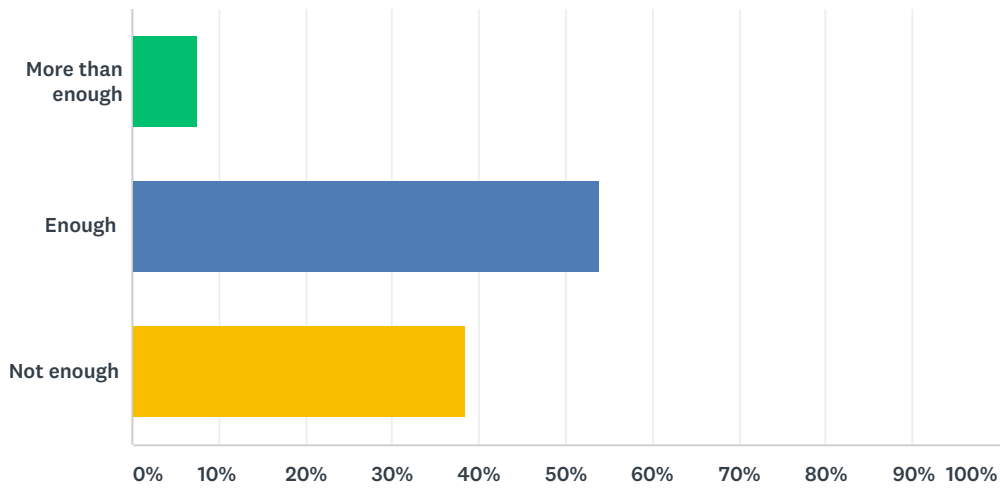

Q25 How would you rate the level of street maintenance undertaken by the Village?

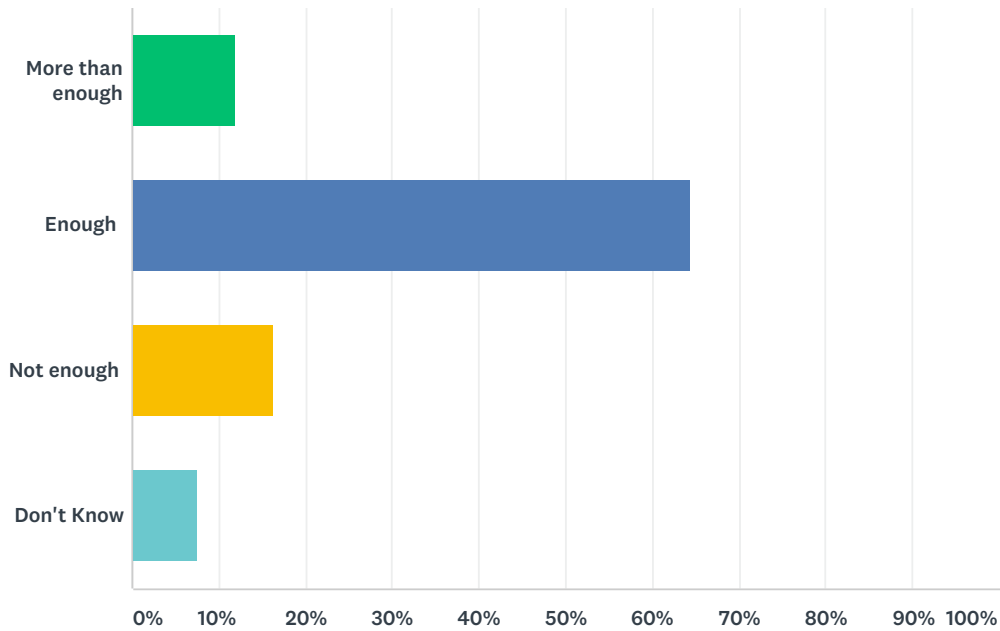

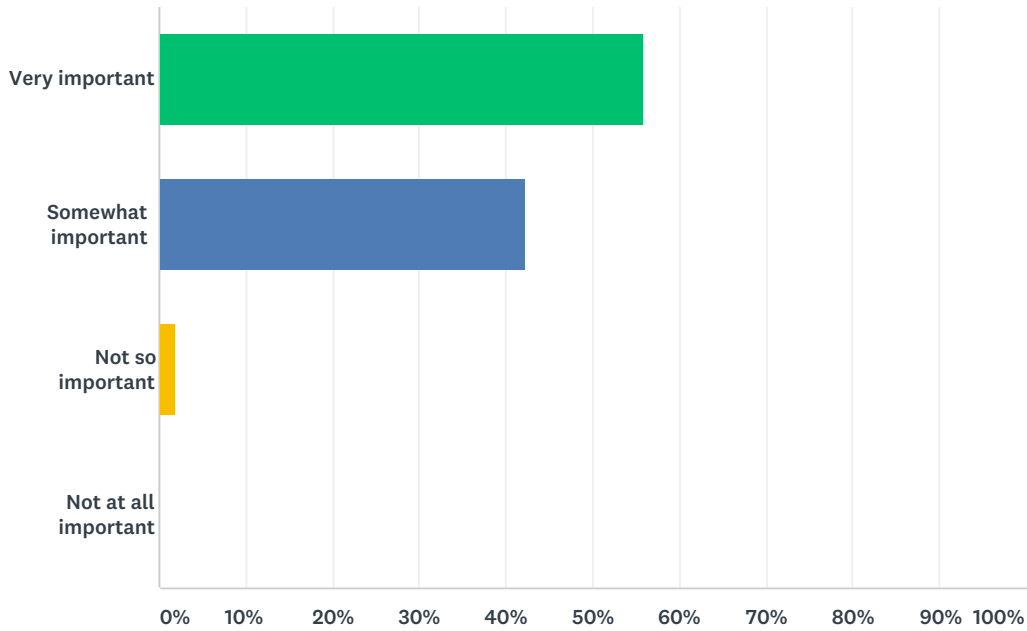

Q27 How important do you consider maintaining or improving the current quality of streets in the Village?

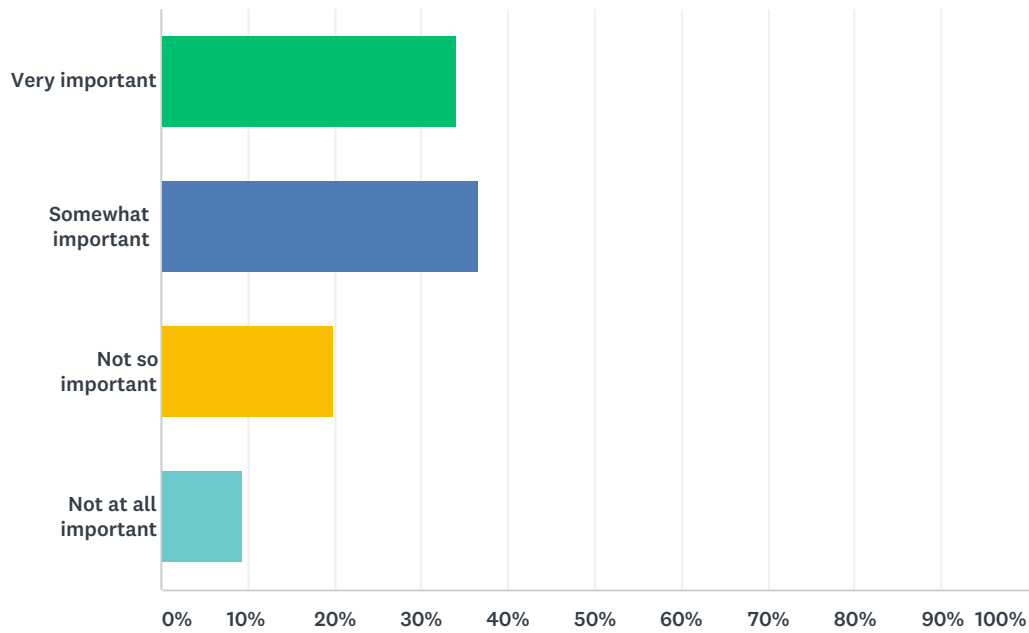

Q28 How important do you feel it is to add on-street bike lanes to Lincoln Avenue and along school routes?

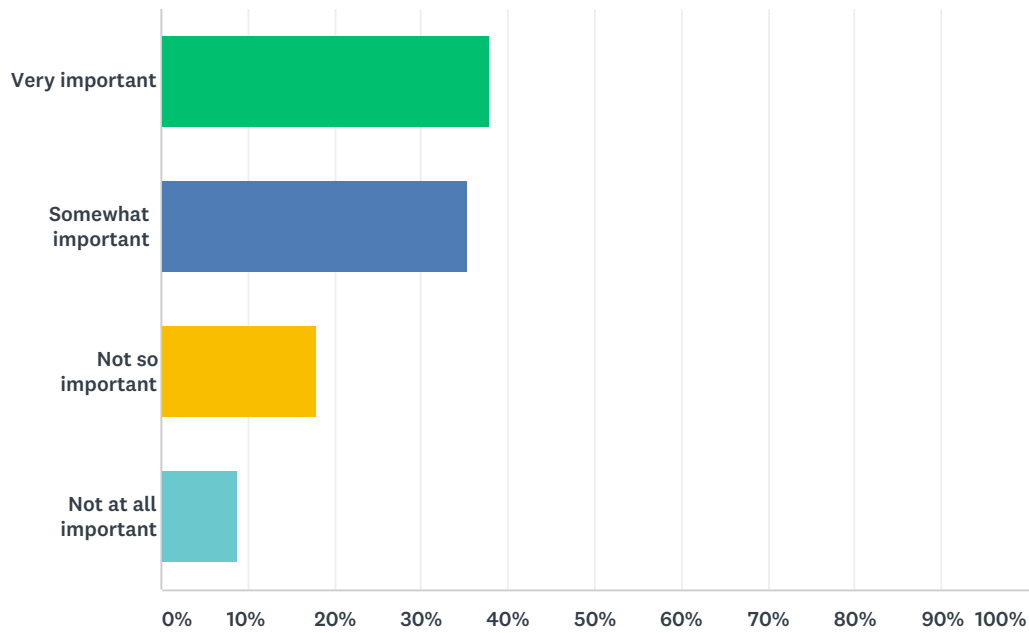
