

ORDINANCE NO. 99-1

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THAT VILLAGE ELECTIONS SHALL BE NONPARTISAN.

THE VILLAGE OF LAKEVIEW ORDAINS:

Section 1: That, as authorized by Chapter III, Section 3(1) and (2) of the General Law Village Act, being Act of 1895, as amended, Village elections in the Village of Lakeview shall hereafter be nonpartisan.

Section 2: This ordinance shall apply beginning with the first Village election for which the nomination deadline is not less than 30 days after the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 3: The Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law. This Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) days after the date of adoption unless a petition signed by not less than ten (10%) percent of the registered electors of the Village is filed with the Village Clerk within the forty-five (45) day period. If a valid petition is filed, the Ordinance shall take effect only after approval by the voters after an election held on the question.

Section 4: Adoption of this Ordinance shall require two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Village Council.
