

ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CONNECTING OF SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS OR NON-MUNICIPALITY OWNED WASTE WATER SYSTEMS WITH THE STREET DRAINAGE SYSTEM ESTABLISHED AND MAINTAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF LAKEVIEW.

THE VILLAGE OF LAKEVIEW ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. All words and phrases used in this ordinance shall have their usual and customary meaning.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm, association or corporation to connect or cause to be connected any sewerage disposal system, or non-municipality owned waste water system with, to, or in any pipe, tile or sewer which is part of the street drainage system, owned, operated and maintained by the Village of Lakeview.

SECTION 3. Any person or person who shall violate this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine or not less than Ten Dollars nor more than One Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment in the common jail of Montcalm County for a period not exceeding ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court, together with the costs of prosecution for such violation as such court may order, and in case such court shall impose a fine and costs only, the person or persons convicted in failing to pay such fine and costs only, the person or persons convicted on failing to pay such fine and costs may be sentenced by the said court to be imprisoned in the said jail for a term not exceeding ninety days, unless payment thereof be sooner made.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect on the 14th day of December, A.D. 1953.

Passed and enacted by the Common Council of the Village of Lakeview in this 9th day of November, A.D. 1953.
