REGULAR COUNCIL MINUTES
November 14, 2016**

AGENDA APPROVAL – Lobert moved and Trevino seconded to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

The Oath of Office was administered to newly elected Council Members – Edwin Winter, Kathy Lobert, Bob Huttinga, and Chris Fryover.

Moved by Lobert and Case seconded to extend appreciation to Esther Collard for her years of service on the Village Council. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – Pat Carr, 10397 Almy Road, Lakeview spoke as Fire Chief and thanked the Village Council for allowing Fire Department to purchase the DPW building. As County Commission, he extended his appreciation to the Council for the service they provide to the Village of Lakeview. He spoke on the vacancy position of Village Manager. He extended his support in combining the Chief of Police position with Village Manager position and reiterated his thoughts and his respect for Chief Dood. He noted the annexation process was able to continue because of Chief Dood's involvement and commitment. He believes Chief Dood has the strong relationships and knowledge for a Village Manager position.

REPORTS

Police Report – Chief Dood reported on blight issues and the recent meeting with the Village Attorney and a resident with building blight issues. President Winter thanked Chief Dood for his work in filling in as Interim Manager.

DPW – Mike Vellanti, DPW Supervisor added to his written report that the lights were recently installed at the Airport. The leaf vacuuming continues and noted the leaf vacuum was shared with Stanton for a few days.

Airport – Clark Newell, Airport Manager, thanked the DPW for their work at the airport. He reported on the option of obtaining an airport courtesy car. This will be on the December agenda. Manager Newell also reported on the issue of deer safety at the airport, which the Council discussed.

Village Manager interviews were conducted for Shay Gallagher and Charles Watson. The Council discussed the interviews as well as the topic of a full-time manager versus a shared service with Stanton City Hall.

Moved by Lobert and Case seconded to proceed with a shared service agreement and offer Shay Gallagher as the Lakeview Village Council candidate of choice. Salaries will be negotiated as comparable to previous Village Manager agreements.
